

**NOTICE OF LAST DAY OF REGISTRATION
FOR THE MAY 2, 2017 SPECIAL ELECTION**

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF:

WAYLAND CITY, DORR TOWNSHIP, HOPKINS TOWNSHIP, LEIGHTON TOWNSHIP, WAYLAND TOWNSHIP

COUNTY OF ALLEGAN, STATE OF MICHIGAN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that an Election will be held on Tuesday, May 2, 2017. The last day for receiving registrations for this Election will be Monday, April 3, 2017. Persons residing in said Cities/Townships registering after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 3, 2017 will not be eligible to vote at the election. Persons planning to register must determine when the office of the City/Township Clerk or the office of the County Clerk or the Secretary of State branch office or other state designated office will be open for registration. Registration by mail may be used by obtaining and completing a Mail Voter Registration Application and forwarding to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. A person who registers to vote by mail is required to vote in person unless he/she has satisfied identification requirements with the local clerk or are at least 60 years of age or are handicapped. Only persons who have registered as electors with the City/Township Clerk or with the County Clerk or through registration at a Secretary of State branch office or other state designated office or by using an official mail registration application, are registered electors of said City/Township.

PERSONS ENTITLED to be registered voters in said City/Township must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the election: (1) a citizen of the United States; (2) not less than 18 years of age; (3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the General Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the election (MCL 168.497).

FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS IN SAID CITY OR TOWNSHIP. YOU MAY REGISTER AT THE OFFICE OF YOUR LOCAL CLERK OR THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK OR THE SECRETARY OF STATE BRANCH OFFICE OR OTHER STATE DESIGNATED OFFICE OR BY OFFICIAL MAIL REGISTRATION. PERSONS REGISTERING TO VOTE AFTER 5:00 P.M. ON APRIL 3, 2017 WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THE MAY 2, 2017 ELECTION.

PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS AS DEFINED BY THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT SHOULD CONTACT THE APPROPRIATE CLERK'S OFFICE.
