

Dorr Township

has curbside recycling collected every other week. Items are placed in special Allied bags available at the Township Hall at 4196 18th St. Look below for materials acceptable for recycling.

Place papers in one bag and metals, glass and plastic in another bag and set out the night before collection.

Homes to the north and on the north side of 142nd Ave. are collected every other Wednesday and homes on the south side and south of 142nd Ave. are collected every other Thursday. If the pick up day falls on or after a holiday, then collection is one day later.

Paperboard—Cereal snack & tissue boxes, remove liners, no wax coated paperboard.

Junk Mail—Envelopes, flyers, brochures, post cards.

Magazines, Phone Books & Catalogs Cardboard & Paper Bags—Flatten cardboard & cut into pieces, no wax coated cardboard.

Glass—Empty clear, green or brown glass.

Metal—Cans must be rinsed out, empty aerosol containers.

Batteries—Seal in Ziploc bags, household only.

Plastics— #1 thru #5 and #7, plastic bottles and jugs empty and rinsed out, plastic grocery bags #2 & #4



Call the Allegan County Health Department if you have **Household Hazardous Waste**, like: **household batteries, oil-based paints, cleaners, expired or unwanted medications, pesticides,**

solvents, compact fluorescent lights, automotive and other chemicals. Bring us your **mercury thermometers** for an exchange! Appointments for drop off are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays during regular business hours. Call 269-673-5415 for your appointment.

OTHER MATERIALS

Large shipping cartons, foamed polystyrene (no packing peanuts), **appliances** and **tires** can be taken to the monitored depot site: **Salem Township Transfer Station** near Burnips on 29th St. 1/4 mile South of 142nd, on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month from 9am to 3 p.m. You must present your resource recovery card. This site is closed Jan. and Feb.
