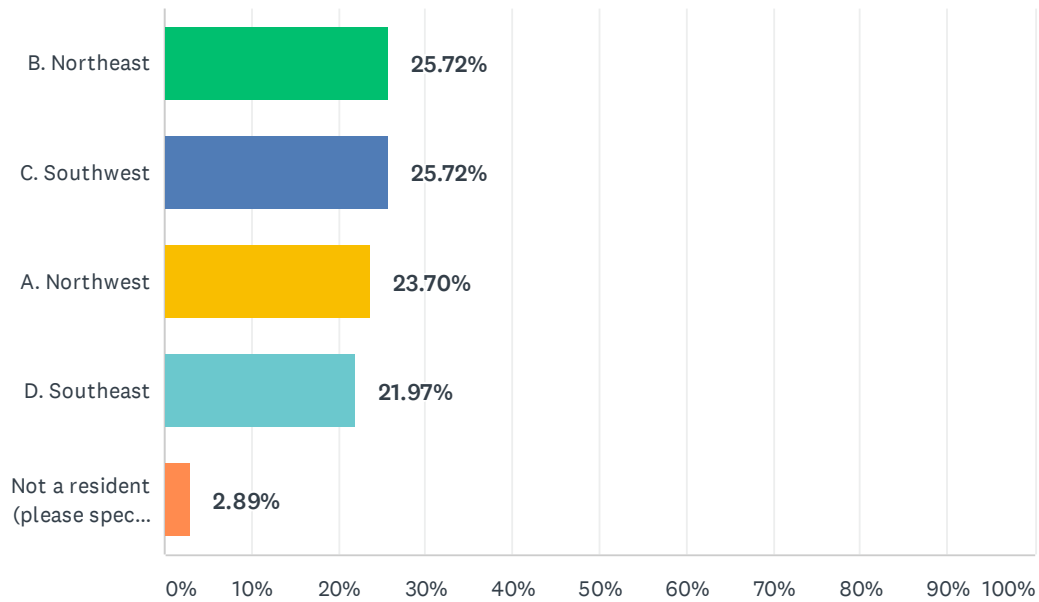


Q1 In which part of the Township do you reside? (Please refer to the map below)

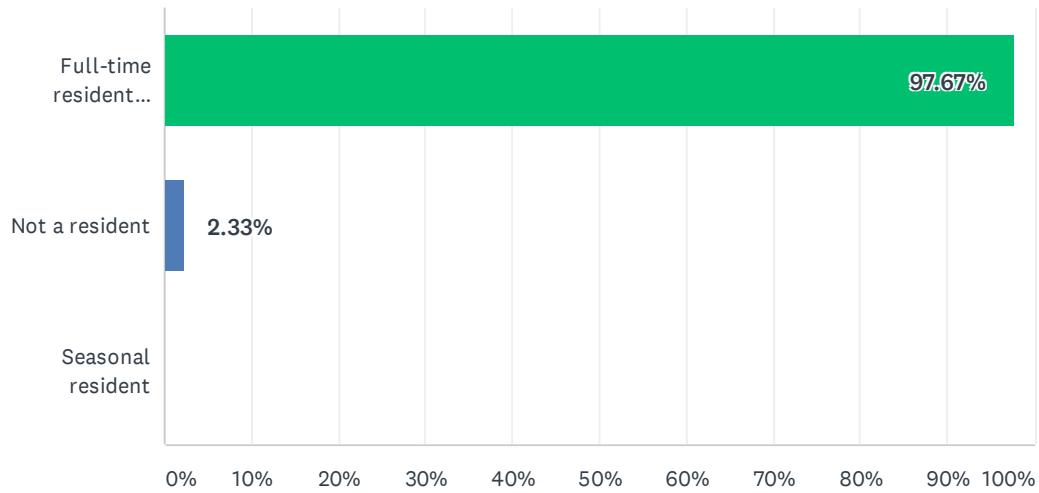

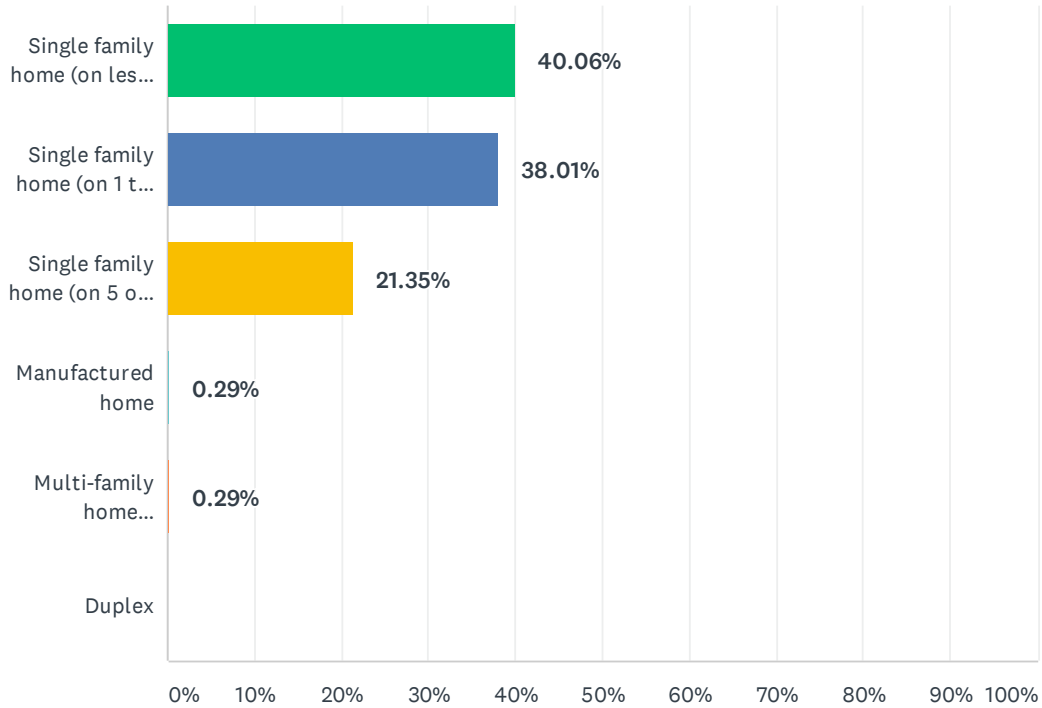

Q3 In what type of residence do you live?

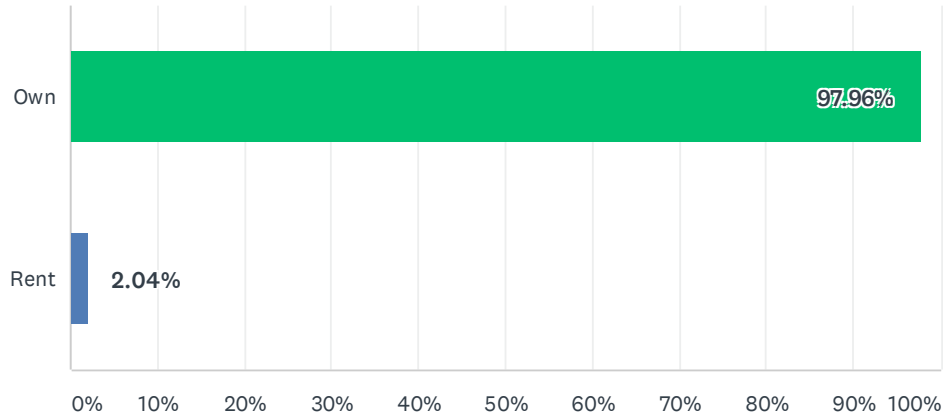

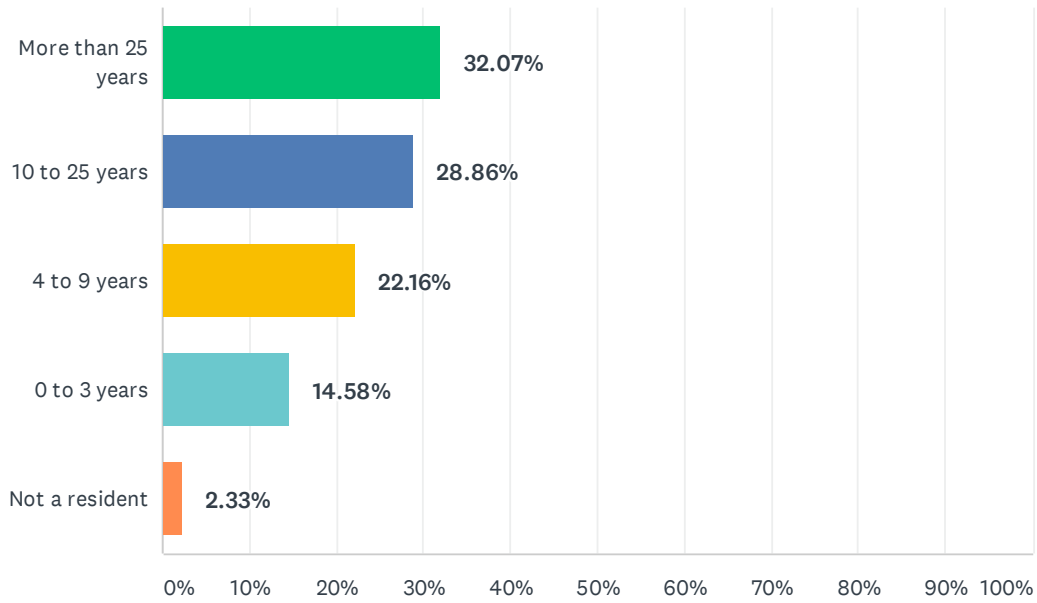

Q5 How long have you lived in Dorr Township?

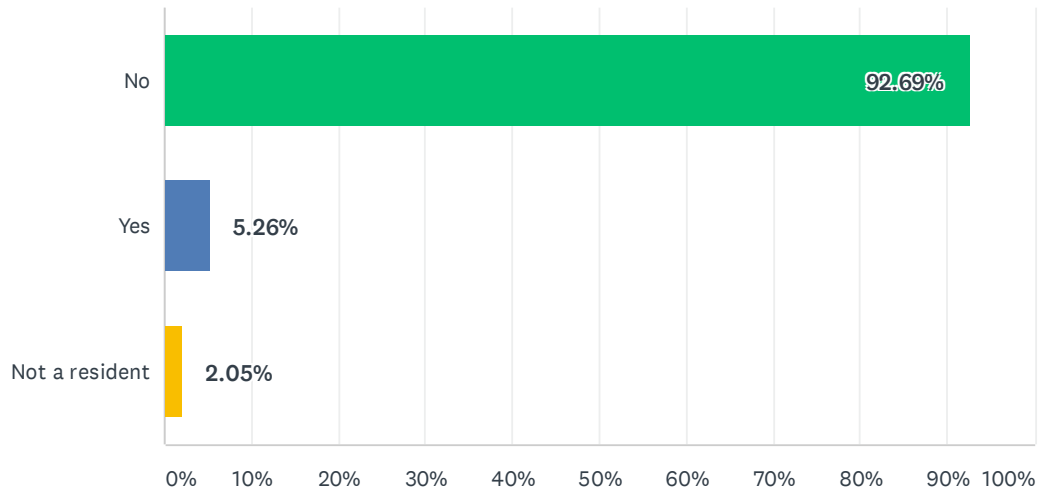

Q6 In the next five years, do you expect to move out of Dorr Township?

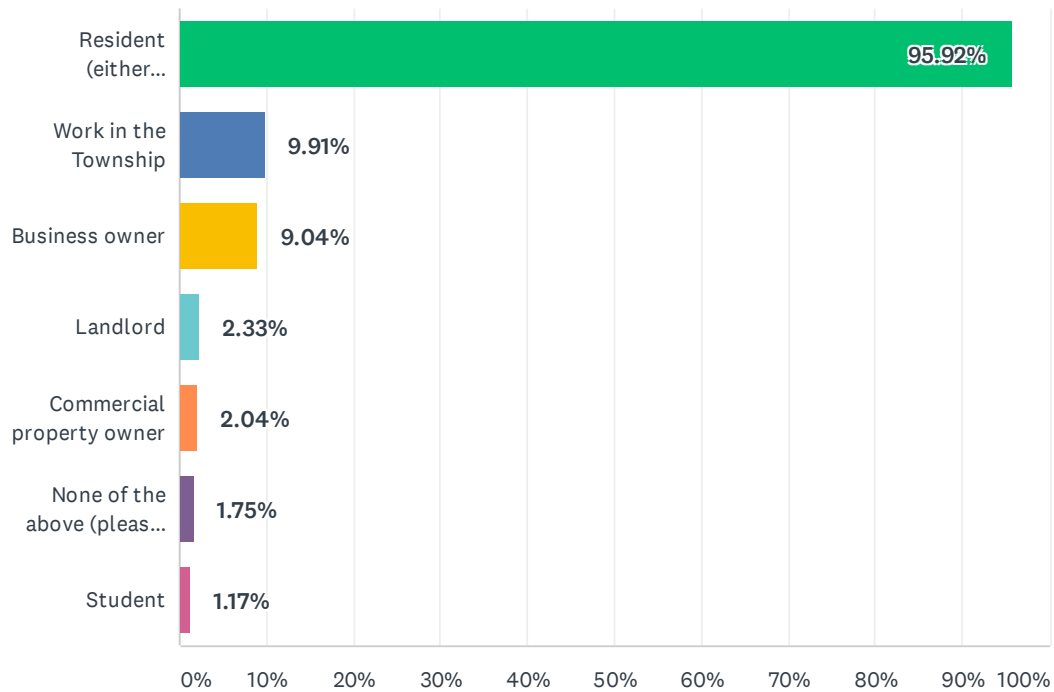

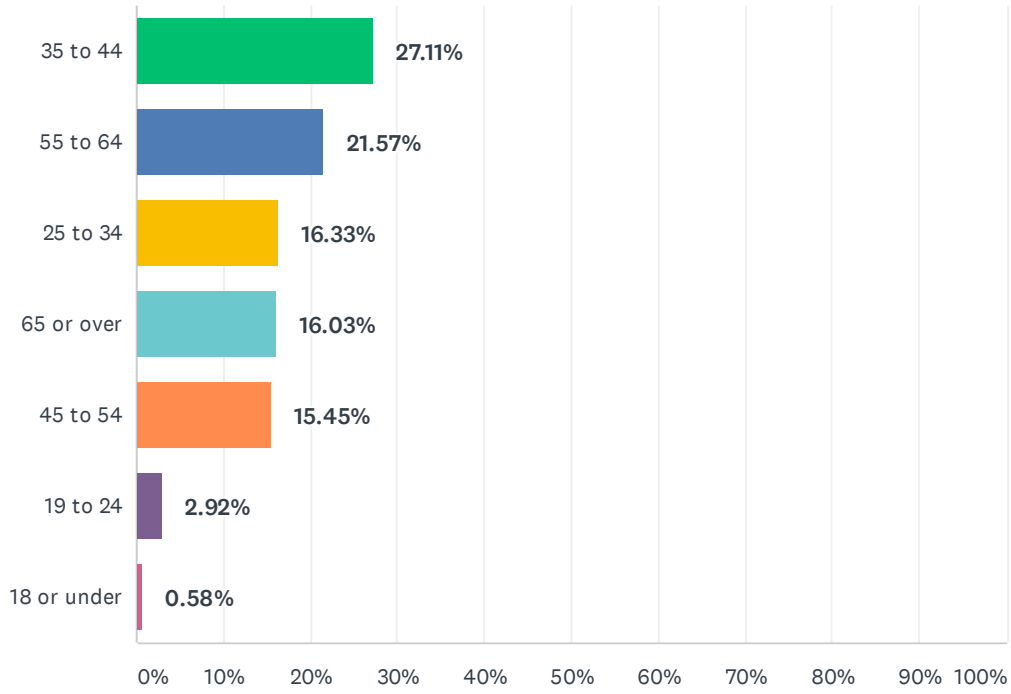
